#### Luke 9:51-56

<sup>51</sup>Now it came to pass, when the time had come for Him to be received up, that He steadfastly set His face to go to Jerusalem,

<sup>52</sup>and sent messengers before His face. And as they went, they entered a village of the Samaritans, to prepare for Him. <sup>53</sup>But they did not receive Him, because His face was *set* for the journey to Jerusalem.

<sup>54</sup>And when His disciples James and John saw *this*, they said, "Lord, do You want us to command fire to come down from heaven and consume them, <sup>[a]</sup>just as Elijah did?"

<sup>55</sup>But He turned and rebuked them, <sup>[b]</sup>and said, "You do not know what manner of spirit you are of. <sup>56</sup><sup>[c]</sup>For the Son of Man did not come to destroy men's lives but to save *them*." And they went to another village.
